

EXTENDED STUDENT OBSERVERSHIP FORM

PURPOSE: *Extended student observerships provide an in-depth opportunity to engage in a mentored research in a lab at Columbia University Medical Center. This research opportunity will provide critical information for students who are required to conduct research as part of an ongoing school program or proposed plan of study. The nature of the observership will be outlined together by the student and appointed research personnel at Columbia and other school mentors/advisors with explicit research goals and deliverables.*

PROCESS: *The interested student needs to: (a) have a school teacher or faculty sponsor willing to mentor and sign off on such an observership; (b) be enrolled in a research program or other course that is related to psychology, biology, neurology or other medical sciences (c) develop, along with the faculty member, a plan of study for this observership; and (d) develop, along with both school and Columbia advisors, a formal means of evaluating the student's work for this course (e.g., formal test, research proposal, poster presentation).*
